If you are booking both the Friday and Saturday evenings, on the Saturday you have the choice of:

- a) a free day in Durham City or
- b) joining the coach which is leaving the Hotel at 9a.m. to travel to Hartlepool to see the '**Tall Ships**' arrive and dock in the Harbour and Marina. A packed meal will be provided for the Hartlepool visit.
