SUNDAY 1st August 2010

Whether you arrive by train into Durham Rail Station or into Newcastle International Airport you will be collected and taken by COACH TRANSPORT to our Luxury 4 Star Marriott Royal County Hotel in Durham City and enjoy a two course Evening DINNER in our Hotel.

MONDAY 2nd August

Breakfast. We leave the Hotel at 9.30am and walk to Durham Cathedral and Durham Castle, where the group is split into smaller parties for Guided Tours of both the Cathedral and Castle. Lunch on your own. 4 pm to 5 pm visit to the Town Hall to receive a 'Civic Reception by the Mayor of Durham.'

6 p.m. Leave Hotel and walk to the Cathedral. 6.15pm - a 'Private I.P.A. Evening Meal in Durham Cathedral', enjoy a Durham menu in the candle-lit Cloisters whilst being entertained by the Durham Constabulary Police Band. The Cathedral will be closed to the public. 10.15 pm walk to our Hotel.

SATURDAY 7th August

Breakfast. Coaches A and B will leave the Hotel at 10.30 a.m. and visit Hartlepool to see the Tall Ships in the Marina and Harbour. (Packed lunch provided). Coaches A and B will return to our Hotel at 6 p.m. Evening Dinner and our 2010 Farewell Celebrations will be held in the neighbouring Three Tuns Hotel which is a 300 yards walk from the Royal County Hotel. After a Late Night of Dancing and Music from the Police Band, we return to our rooms in the Royal County Hotel.
